Register NOW to join a Belmont sports team for TERM 1 2022

Playing sport in a Belmont School team is lots of fun and a great way for both students and whanau to meet others in our school community. All sports on offer are suitable for beginners so it's a great time to try something new and represent your school!

Registration is due 4 February 2022. Fees will be added to your child's account and will need to be paid in full by 11 February 2022.

PLEASE NOTE: You will be unable to register your child for summer sports teams if they have overdue sports fees from previous years.

COVID-19 Update:

- Mandatory Vaccinations for Education came into effect on Monday 25 October 2021. If you are offering to coach a sports team, you will be required to show proof of your Covid-19 vaccination status.
- Each sports code will have slightly different requirements depending on what level of the Covid-19 Protection Framework we are in. This information will be communicated to families as soon as possible.

<i>Touch Rugby: Year 1-2 is Open Grade, Year 3-4 and 5-6 are either Boys, Girls or Mixed grades. Games are 5 aside and played on half fields. Teams may have an after school or lunchtime training session at school.</i>

<i>Floorball: Floorball is a small sided indoor hockey type game with lightweight sticks and balls (provided). 3 outfielders and 1 goal keeper play the game and teams have two subs. Belmont School Netball Registration Form Years 1 -4 Term 1 2022

Netball is available to all Year 1-4 students at Belmont School. Belmont School enters teams in a Netball NZ programme called futureFERNs that runs for 6 weeks. We enter teams in Term 1 and again in Term 4.

Year 1-2 futureFERNs introduces Netball to 5-6 year olds with the aim to develop fundamental movement and basic netball skills. The 4 v 4 game format allows players to pass, catch and shoot from day one.

Year 3-4 futureFERNs is designed to be fast and fun maximising participation and touches of the ball. Along with modified equipment and less players on the court the 5v5 game is less complicated.

Sessions are loads of fun and include skill development activities and a game of modified netball. Games are played at Netball Hutt Valley (Taita Courts) on Saturday mornings. Year 1&2 teams are usually allocated a set time of either 9 or 10am). Times for Year 3&4 are yet to be confirmed however staff will try to allocate teams the same game times each week. **The season starts on Saturday 19 February and runs for 6 weeks.** The last game will be played on 26 March (or Sunday 27 March, which is the rain out day). Netball Hutt Valley's coordinators lead the sessions on game day, and each Year 1 & 2 team has a Star Helper and Year 3 & 4 team has a Star Coach who helps their team to do the activities as demonstrated. For each team entered by Belmont School we need at least one Star Helper / Star Coach to attend the free training workshops at Taita Courts. Year 1 & 2 Star Helper workshop is on on **Wednesday 16 February (7.00-8.30pm)**, Star Helpers need no previous netball experience. Star Helpers may choose not to take any training sessions at school during the week as the players will learn skills on game day.

Year 3 & 4 Star Coach workshop is on **Thursday 17 February (6.00pm)** at the Taita Courts. Star Coaches will be actively involved during the session. Our Junior Coordinators will lead a group of teams for the skills, but coaches take their own warm-up and cool-down. At game time, a coach from each team is an on-court to support the players (there is no umpire with a whistle).

Please note:

- When registering your child to play it is expected that they show a commitment by turning up and participating in all games. If for any reason you cannot attend a game you must contact the team's Star Helper or the school office as soon as possible.
- The registration fee of \$45 (subject to change) includes loan of uniforms, and Belmont School medals and certificates for the players at the end of the season. Fees must be paid for children to be placed in a team.

Belmont School Touch Rugby Registration Form Years 1 - 6 Term 1 2022

Touch Rugby is available to all Belmont students (Years 1-6). Belmont School enters teams in the Total Touch competitions that run for 6 weeks in Term 1 and again in Term 4.

- Games will be played on **Thursday afternoons at Fraser Park** (starting from 4pm) starting on 24 February
- The Year 1-2 grade is an Open Grade, Year 3-4 boys, girls or mixed, and Year 5-6 boys, girls or mixed.
- All Primary School grades will be played on half fields with 5 aside. There is a 2 girl minimum for Mixed Grades.
- There will be a practice during the week. The day and time your child trains will depend on the availability of the Coach for your child's team and is likely to be at lunchtime or straight after school.

The organisers of the competition post the draw information generally on the Monday afternoon before the game and a link to the draw will be available on the school website or you can visit www.totaltouch.org.nz. **The number of teams that we enter into this competition is dependent on how many coaches we have.**

Belmont School Floorball Registration Form Years 3-6 Term 1 2022

Floorball is available to Year 3-6 Students. The Floorball league has limited spaces for team entries, but we have several team places on hold for our teams. We will accept registrations on a first in first served basis, and then wait-list additional players.

- Games will be played on **Wednesday afternoons at the Walter Nash Centre** (between 4.00pm and 6.30pm) from 9 February for approx 8 weeks. A draw will be made available for the whole term.
- Games are 2 x 10 min with a 2 minute break. There are 3 outfield players and one goal keeper plus 2 subs. Each team has their own coach/manager that manages the subs and looks after the team. Referees are provided. Sticks and goalie helmets are provided. If anyone is able to sponsor some gloves and helmet for our teams please comment below.
- Teams will not have a training day for this league but players will need to arrive early on game day to warm up.
