# **BASKETBALL INFORMATION WINTER 2022**

Term 2 fees will be added to your child's account and are payable on or before **13 April 2022**. Late entries will only be accepted if a space is available.

Basketball is available to **YEAR 1-6** students in Terms 2 and 3. Games are played at the Walter Nash Centre in Taita. Players will be provided with a sports uniform, and need to wear their own sneakers.

Belmont School enters teams into Basketball Hutt Valley's competitions providing they have space available. Beginners are welcome. Mixed teams need to have one girl on court at all times. Term 2 & 3 dates are as follows;

Teams are entered by school for Term 2 and then school must re-enter for Term 3. When players register to play Basketball for Belmont they are committing to playing for their team for **both terms**. The fee paid to school includes the team's entry into the competition, medals and certificates for players, uniforms, and training equipment. This fee will be split with Term 3 charged to you once the team's registration has been accepted. At the end of the season a Belmont Sports Celebration will be held to celebrate players' participation, award medals and certificates and thank their Coaches and Managers for their support and commitment.

Tiniball games are 10 minutes each way, and Miniball 11 minutes each way, both with a one minute break at half time. Start times will vary, but are usually scheduled between 3.50pm and 7.00pm. # YEAR 5 & 6 NETBALL INFORMATION WINTER 2022

Late entries will only be accepted if a space is available.

Netball is available to all **YEAR 5 & 6** students during Terms 2 and 3. Beginners are welcome. Belmont School enters teams for the full season with Netball Hutt Valley, and games are played at the Taita Netball Courts on Monday afternoons.

Players will be provided with a sports uniform. Players need appropriate sports shoes, and may choose to wear a long sleeved black thermal and/or black full length leggings for outside games. No jewellery may be worn (earrings may NOT be taped) and fingernails need to be short & smooth. Hair needs to be tied back.

**Year 5-6 teams** play futureFERNs netball on Mondays (times vary, start 4.00pm, finish by 6.30pm). This age group will have a practice at school. Year 5-6 teams do their own warm up then play a game of 6v6 netball (4 x 8 min quarters). Teams need to supply their own umpire. Free practical umpiring sessions available on grading weeks. A Coach for each team needs to attend the free training on either 11 April or 2 May. You will get access to an online resource book for the season. Click [here](#) for more information.
