YEAR 1- 6 BASKETBALL INFORMATION WINTER 2023

REGISTRATIONS DUE FRIDAY 31 MARCH 2023

Email the registration form to sports@belmont-lowerhutt.school.nz, return to the letterbox at the office or complete the [online google form](#). Term 2 fees will be added to your child's account and are payable on or before **6 April 2023**. Late entries will only be accepted if a space is available. Term 3 fees will be added at a later stage.

Please note: If we do not have enough coaches/managers for the number of players registered, then your child's placement in a team will depend on the order in which their registration and payment was received.

Basketball is available to **YEAR 1-6** students in Terms 2 and 3. Games are played at the Walter Nash Centre in Taita. Players will be provided with a sports uniform, and need to wear their own sneakers.

Belmont School enters teams into Basketball Hutt Valley's competitions providing they have space available. Beginners are welcome. Term 2 dates are as follows, Term 3 dates are to be confirmed;.

Teams are entered by school for Term 2 and then school must re-enter for Term 3. When players register to play Basketball for Belmont they are committing to playing for their team for **both terms**. The fee paid to school includes the team's entry into the competition, medals and certificates for players, uniforms, and training equipment. This fee will be split with Term 3 charged to you once the team's registration has been accepted. At the end of the season a Belmont Sports Celebration will be held to celebrate players' participation, award medals and certificates and thank their Coaches and Managers for their support and commitment.

Tiniball (Y 1-4) games are 10 minutes each way, and Miniball (Y 5 & 6) are 11 minutes each way, both with a one minute break at half time. Start times will vary, but are usually scheduled between 3:30pm and 6:30pm. YEAR 5 & 6 NETBALL INFORMATION WINTER 2023

Please note: If we do not have enough coaches/managers for the number of players registered, then your child's placement in a team will depend on the order in which their registration and payment was received.

Netball is available to all **YEAR 5 & 6** students during Terms 2 and 3. Beginners are welcome. Belmont School enters teams for the full season with Netball Hutt Valley, and games are played at the Taita Netball Courts on Monday afternoons.

Players will be provided with a sports uniform. Players need appropriate sports shoes, and may choose to wear a long sleeved black thermal and/or black full length leggings for outside games. No jewellery may be worn (earrings may NOT be taped) and fingernails need to be short & smooth. Hair needs to be tied back.

Year 5-6 teams play futureFERNs netball on Mondays (times vary, start 4.00pm, finish by 6.30pm). This age group will have a practice at school. Year 5-6 teams do their own warm up then play a game of 6v6 netball (4 x 8 min quarters). Teams need to supply their own [umpire](#). A Coach for each team needs to attend the free training on Tuesday 2 May. Netball Hutt Valley have a great website with lots of [resources](#). WATERPOLO INFORMATION TERM 3 2023

Waterpolo is available to **YEAR 5-6** students in Term 3 and is played at Stokes Valley Pool. Players need to wear their own togs, there is no uniform. The competition will run on Wednesday's starting on **Wednesday 19 July through to finals night on Wednesday 20 September**. Game times will vary, but will be scheduled to start between 4 pm and 6 pm. The registration fee for Waterpolo is **\$50.00**.

Please note: If we do not have enough coaches/managers for the number of players registered, then your child's placement in a team will depend on the order in which their registration and payment was received.

Games are 10 minutes each way with a 2 minute change of ends at half time.

The competition is graded and suits beginners as well as those who have played before. The pool has a depth of 1.2-1.4m so the ability to swim with confidence and tread water is essential. There is a maximum of 8 players per team, with 5 in the pool at one time (a goalie and 4 field players) with 3 substitutes sitting poolside behind the two-metre red cone.

The \$50 registration fee paid to school will include the team's entry into the competition as well as medals and certificates for players for the end of term Sports Celebration.

More information on registering for Waterpolo will be emailed out to Year 5 & 6 families in Term 2.
