Everyone involved with Belmont School Sport is expected to follow Fair Play rules and be responsible, well behaved representatives of our School.

Good sport is about having a positive attitude. You can set the right tone and help make the game a success. Play your part, and play fair.

If you have any issues throughout the season, please communicate with the School first before making any complaints to Coaches, Managers, Volunteers or Sports Providers.

Please ensure you read this Code of Conduct carefully and share it with your child before registering them for their chosen sport.

BELMONT SCHOOL SPORTING POLICY:

- I have a responsibility to listen to my coach and try my best at all times. I realise they give up a lot of their free time to train me
- I have a responsibility to attend all trainings and give 100% attention and effort when there
- I have a responsibility to turn up to the game at the assigned time
- I have a responsibility to inform my coach as soon as possible if I am unable to attend a practice or game
- I have a responsibility to my teammates to be a supportive team member at all times and to realise I am no more important than anyone else in my team
- I will abide by all umpiring/refereeing decisions and appreciate that these people have given up their time to enable me to play
- I have a responsibility to myself that I give 100% effort at all times, so I can be proud of myself

THE FAIRPLAY PROMISE FOR BELMONT SCHOOL STUDENTS/PLAYERS:

To the best of my ability I will:

- Play by the rules
- Never argue with an official
- Work hard to do my best at all times
- Turn up to practice
- Be a good sport and recognise good players and good plays by all involved
- Remember to thank my coach, the officials, the opposition and supporters
- Help others in my team when I can
- Avoid putting people down and bullying them

THE FAIRPLAY PROMISE FOR BELMONT SCHOOL PARENTS/CAREGIVERS AND SUPPORTERS:

To the best of my ability I will:

- Encourage my child, and other people's children, in their efforts in sport
- Insist that my child plays within the rules and by the principles of fair play
- Respect my child's efforts the same regardless of whether s/he has won or lost
- Display self control on the sideline. Be positive, never shout at or ridicule players
- Watch my child play and let him/her enjoy the game
- Show my appreciation and respect to people who volunteer their time so my child can play and practise
- Remember that my child plays sport for his/her reasons not mine
- Never place undue pressure on my child to play or perform
- Give it heaps and don't get ugly
