



Covid-19 Alert Level 2 Protocols: “Playing it Safe”

Quick Check List for Parents/Caregivers

This quick check list tells you the things you need to know about drop off, pick up and what to do around others at school at level 2.

What’s different under Level 2 at Belmont School?

1 You can only come to school if you are well.

Children must not come to school if they are unwell. This means if they have a cough, a runny nose, difficulty breathing, or if they have been in contact with anyone who has these things. This doesn’t just mean any of the signs of Covid-19, it means any signs of being unwell. This is for the safety of all our children and staff.

2 Drop off and pick up your children at one of the school gates. School staff will be there to help.

Don’t come in the gate unless you have to.

If you come into the school, for any reason, you need to scan our QR code or fill out a form for contract tracing each time. This is so if anyone gets sick we know who has come into the school.

We encourage parents and caregivers to wear a mask for drop off and pick up.

3 If you have to come to the office, one in, one out.

Children who come late to school will need to come to the office before they go to class. Children can give all notices/forms to teachers. The silver letterbox in the office is closed.

4 Please keep your distance from other parents, whānau, children and teachers / staff.
